PLANET's PAC Matching Contributions Gifts to Charity Challenge

Starting now, you can make a contribution to the PLANET PAC and designate PLANET to make a matching contribution to the **PLANET AEF, Project EverGreen, or another charity** of your choice that is tax-exempt under 26 U.S.C. §501(c) (3). **Note:** *You can not personally receive any financial or tangible benefit (such as a tax deduction or a premium from the recipient charity) as a result of PLANET's gift.*

This year, PLANET has set aside a total of \$10,000 in matching funds for this challenge. You have the option to simply make a contribution to the PLANET PAC, *or* make a contribution and designate a charity to which you wish PLANET to donate the matching funds. **Please note:** *Each contribution to the PLANET PAC will be matched up to \$1,000. Once the \$10,000 in matching funds PLANET has set aside is reached, no further matching contributions will be made by PLANET.*
